I hope you are well both physical and spiritual conditions as I pray, I thank God for His mercy to each and every one of us despite all challenges facing us.

This is to thank you all for receiving your support recently for third quarter of the year. I pray God to bless you all more abundantly for your unrelenting effort to keep the word of truth going on in various parts of this area and, I still visits some local churches around here to keep them strong in the sound doctrine of Christ. For example, last Sunday being 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2019 the church at a place called (Ugwuoba town) about 8 miles from Awka Anambra State invited me to teach them on what the “ Anointing” means, in the new testament (I Jn. 2:27), this I did and they are very happy and edified when they understand the topic of that lesson. I made them to understand that anointing is the word of God which one believed and abide with, through the Holy spirit (Jn.17:17, Eph. 3:17), with more other passages of New testament I used to explain it more clearly to all in the church. Penticostal sects teach that anointing is when someone receives baptism of Holy Spirit as apostles received, this we disprove scripturally.

Brethren, we are trying through God’s grace pushing the gospel truth on progressively here, but our problem is insecurity threat here by Fulani herdsmen, Boko haram and other Islamic insurgent groups, this makes people here to live in fear always, and government are doing less or nothing to arrest this situation, not talking about poverty and bad economic condition that are ravaging people here, in short people are suffering too much. So brethren pray for us for God’s protection of His people and less privileged ones. Over 350 people were killed by insurgency in various parts of Nigeria last month of June alone, the newspaper reported this month July so pray for us, I will stop here and will write more detail next mail, thank you and be more blessed as I repeat in my prayers for you in Jesus Name. Amen.
