Our Wednesday evening bible class is continuing the study from the series "The Church Jesus Built" put together by brother Mark Copeland. We will be studying "How To Establish Authority" this coming Wednesday evening.

I am able to better prepare myself and to continue to study in God's Word without having to worry about concerning myself with a job that would take me away from my work in the Lord.
