Dear Brethren,

I pray all is well with you. Our rejoicing continues over the baptism of a woman on the 21st who has several family members in this congregation. On the 9th, we had a singing on Monday night. Several members from other congregations were in attendance.

I visited 11 people this month for a total of 20 visits. One visit was to the hospital ICU where we actually had a short Bible study with a man. Efforts have been made to study more. I assisted one member in getting to and from the hospital for surgery.

Let me further report on some results from the booth at the Delta Fair. We sent out 22 correspondence courses, of which four have returned the first lesson. Three other people who took the course last year are working on their courses also. One man requested a Bible for himself and his 11 and 12 year old daughters. Several members helped make this possible. A woman taking the course has requested a Bible also. On the 23rd I attempted to set up a study with one young man taking the course who showed a lot of interest at the fair. We both were going to bring someone with us, but after talking with his person he backed out of having the study. However, he is still interested in discussing the Bible by email. All of a sudden, I have several leads for studies.

Articles for the local column in the newspaper included: Trust God; Heaven's Tableland; Integrity; and Jedidiah. Sermons I preached this month included: I Am Neither Jew, Catholic, Protestant, But A Christian Only; A Little Good News Today; The Bible Is The Inspired Word of God (proofs); Preaching The Gospel By Parables; Authority Or Anarchy; Archaeology; The Life I Now Live; Approve The Things That Are Excellent; and Meeting My Responsibilities. On the 9th, I recorded a lesson to be used on the cable TV program. The sermon was: God Said It, That Settles It.

Other events in the area that we attended included: 1) A study on the 7th at the Northside congregation in Jonesboro, AR on "Building Godly Marriages" conducted by Shawn and Diane Bain. 2) A gospel meeting at Newbern, TN with Brian Sullivan. May God continue to bless our efforts for the Master's cause!
