The first week of each month I will attempt to begin work on 4 articles for the newspaper and articles for the two bulletins I publish each month. Also, I will pick and start working on sermons for the month. By doing this, I could use the other 3 weeks of the month to focus more on working in the community.

I had one lady to finish "Jesus The Way" Bible correspondence course. I attended two different funerals during the month on the 9th and 19th. I made 9 visits to 6 people. On the 18th, James Lively and I made one visit. On the 31st, Russell and I made one visit and attempted to see another. On the 27th, Janis and I went to a singing at Medina, TN which they have every year in January. May God continue to bless our combined efforts for the Master.
