#### **EVANGELISTIC WORK:**

The local Church in San Miguel de Allende is very grateful for all the effort that you have made to help the evangelistic work in this region continue. We have been richly blessed in the preaching of the Gospel. This year we have had great results in exhortation, edification and spiritual growth.

#### **SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE:**

We are very grateful to God because this year He has been gracious to us and kept us strong in various circumstances. 95% of the congregation has remained faithful in spite of various tests we have faced, such as false doctrines introduced by brethren from other congregations who tried to divert the truth. The congregation was affected emotionally but has overcome and now the members are more mature and stronger to face such problems.

Although this year we had only one baptism of our brother Josue, our attendance has still been increasing due to a number of visitors.

The men of the congregation continue to participate in teaching: Juan Huerta, Antonio Rayas, Antonio González, Carlos Arturo Rojas, Emmanuel Salazar, brother Arturo Vazquez and Jose Luis Ramirez. Their improvement in the exposition of the word is noticeable. Some of them have the availability to support the preaching in other nearby congregations. They go to preach to San Felipe when I have to be preaching somewhere else.

This year we received some financial help for the construction of the church building. Some of our brothers in Mission Tx, Hueytown Alabama, and Reynosa, the Calderon family. Together with contributions and hard work of the brethren here we made remarkable advances in our building.

My family and myself have worked week after week in the local teaching, and also traveling to other congregations to help them in preaching. As a result a new congregation has been founded in Apaseo el Alto. So far we have not suspended any commitment to help these congregations, and our desire is to continue working in the same way next year.

The Church of Christ in Hueytown, Alabama has helped me financially for more than 14 years. Due to their insufficient income they can no longer support me for next year 2016. This greatly affects our work in these various congregations because it forces us to make changes in how much travel we can continue to do and also affects the finances of our family. We do not want to neglect any new members who have been baptized outside San Miguel de Allende, many of whom are new to the gospel. Please pray for us soon to be supplied for this need.
