**TIERRA BLANCA.** We thank GOD for his fidelity to us during this year. After some months of preaching the gospel in Tierra Blanca (45 minutes outside of San Miguel), 46-year-old Eliza decided to be baptized, in spite of her physical situation, with advanced cancer in her stomach and part of her body, she in full knowledge decided to obey and surrender her life to the Lord, confessing Jesus Christ as the son of God. With the help of the brothers she was submerged in the waters for baptism. A few weeks later she passed away. We give glory to God for allowing her to be part of his kingdom. On the same day of Eliza's baptism; Felicitas and Rebecca, who have listened to the gospel for several months, expressed their great need to give themselves to the Lord as well. Both were baptized for the forgiveness of their sins. Since then Felicitas has opened her home to have meetings every week on Mondays at 8 p.m.. where we are visited by 20-25 non-believers. Now Felicitas and Rebeca meet with us in San Miguel de Allende. During the month of March, Juan Antonio, who has visited us for some time, made the decision to be baptized, and we rejoice that now his wife and children attend the meetings with him. We also thank God for the baptism of the young Alan in that same month.

**GOSPEL MEETINGS IN OTHER CITIES.** Our brothers in Reynosa Tamaulipas who meet in Nayarit Street invited me to preach to them the second week of April. The meeting was of great encouragement to me and to the congregation. We thank God for the baptism of Alejandra, Hector and Cecilia.
